3. This event is a Soccer tournament focused around Michigan Tourism, gathering here in West Michigan.
4. While MFC will have a trophy awarded for our club, this will not cause any disruption for OUSA associated teams.
5. MFC select coaches without State teams may play OUSA games or "play team" if absolutely necessary. We'd prefer a trophy awarded.
